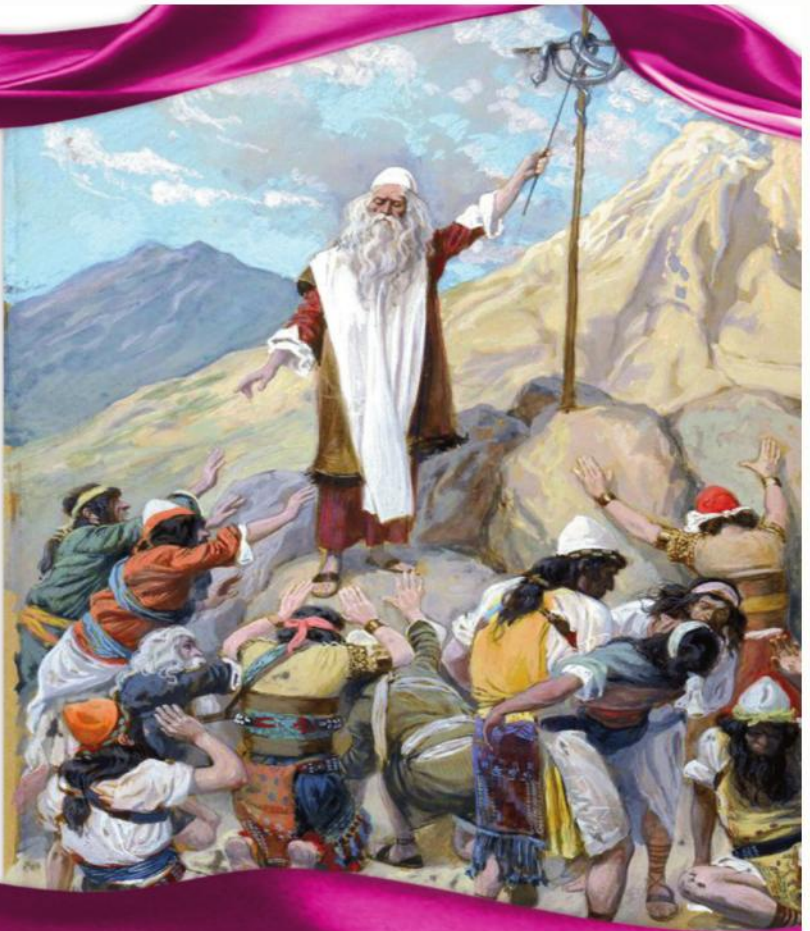

Our Lenten Sacrifice

Days of Abstinence - All Fridays in Lent, & Good Friday for all who have reached their 14th birthday, no meat can be taken.

Days of Fast - Good Friday for all who have reached their 18th birthday and have not as yet reached their 60th birthday, a limit of one full meatless meal.

Weekdays of Lent - No obligation to fast; however, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended.

Easter Duty Obligation - Must be made from the first Sunday in Lent through Trinity Sunday.

Self Denial - is encouraged on a voluntary basis. Acts may include daily Mass, spiritual study, Lenten Devotions, the Rosary, Stations of the Cross, and deeds of mercy and kindness.

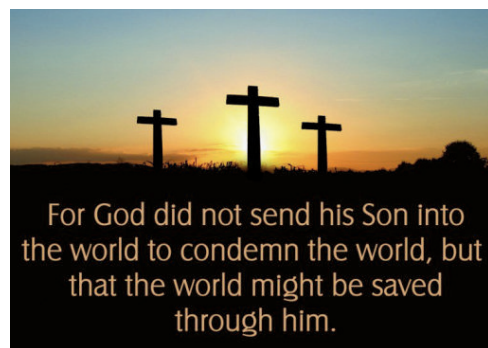

**Can You Help a Poor Child Attend
Fr. Peter's School in Nigeria?**

Father Peter sends a big "THANK YOU" from Nigeria for the many school improvements (running water, new classrooms, bathrooms, kitchen, etc.) made possible with the help of St. Anthony's and St. Mary's parishes. Father will return in July for his annual fundraising for other improvements, such as a library and a chapel.

Fr. Peter has recently told us about another kind of need-tuition assistance for very poor families that can't afford the school's tuition. Father explains:

As the reputation of our school has spread, more families-many with just one parent, sometimes a widowed mother-want very much to send their children to our school but are too poor to pay the tuition. Also, some boys are orphans. Currently, we have 33 boys who need tuition aid in order to attend.

- \$100 will enable one boy to attend 1 of the 3 school terms.
- \$200 will pay for 2 terms.
- \$300 will pay for 3 terms-a full school year.
- Smaller donations toward the cost of a school term are also appreciated.

If you are interested in helping in this way, kindly use the "Father Peter's Students" envelopes available at each Church entrance (make the check payable to either St Anthony's or St Mary's Church with the notation, *Fr.
