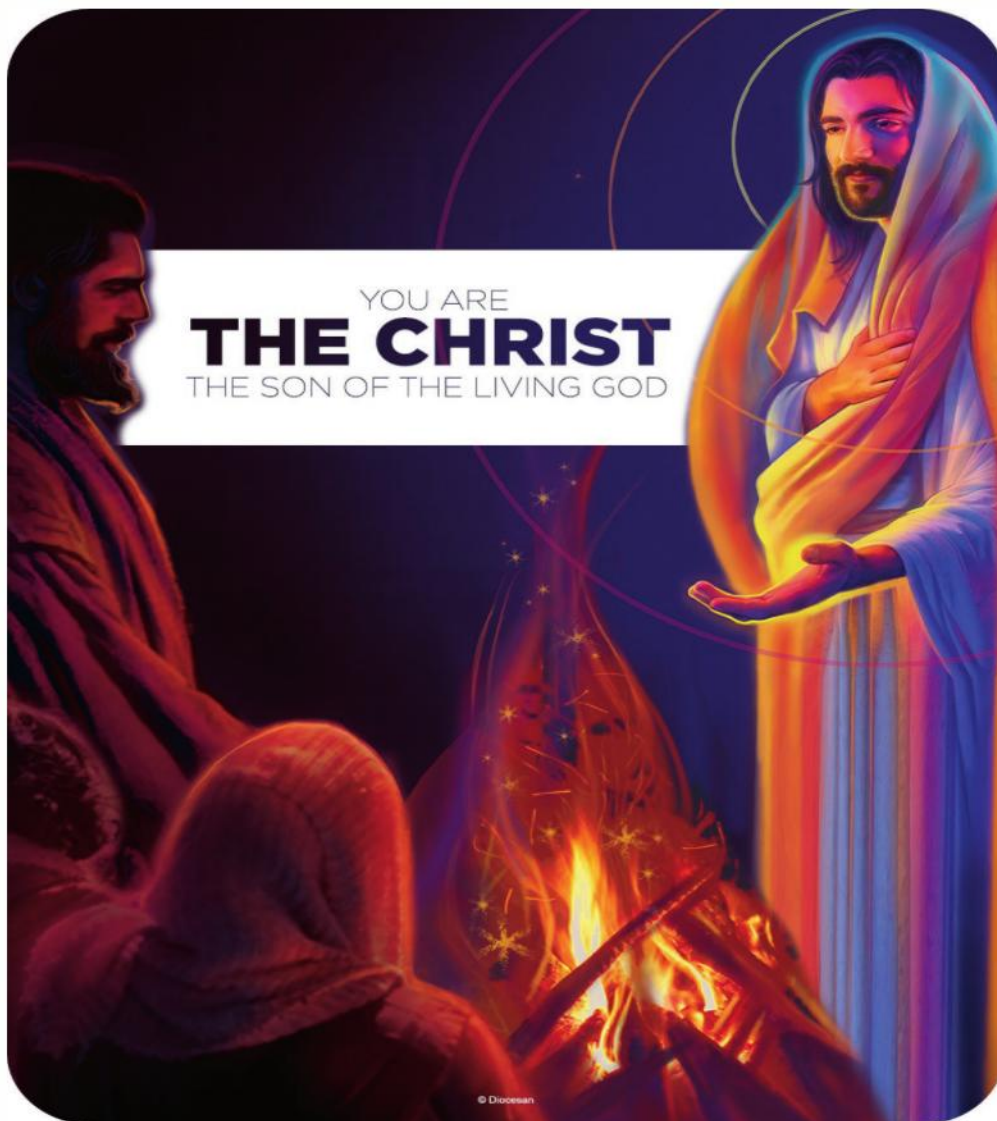

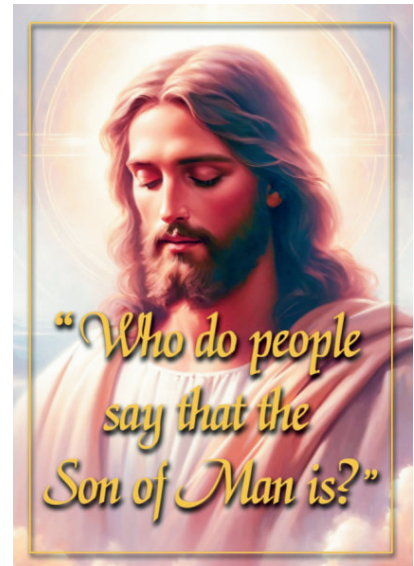

**Marriage Preparation:** Marriage arrangements should be made at least 6 months in advance by calling the parish office for an appointment. Pre-Cana attendance is required.

**Anointing and Visits to the Sick:** Please notify the Parish Center of a family member's admission to a hospital or nursing care facility, or of confinement at home to arrange for spiritual care, Holy Communion and/or Anointing of the Sick. The Mass from St Mary's is televised on cable channel 2 at 10 AM on Sunday mornings.

**Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA):** Are you interested in becoming a Catholic? OCIA (formerly called RCIA) is a process for becoming a fully initiated member of the Catholic Faith. It is for those who are seeking Baptism in the Catholic Faith, those who have been baptized in another Christian tradition and now seek to be a member of the Catholic Faith, and for those who have been baptized Catholic but have not received the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist.
